- 1.** When you think of drought, what comes to mind?

  - a. Drought (or disaster) related materials, response/mitigation plans, outreach information, tools demographic data, etc.,
  
- 6.** What organizations or groups do you feel could relate to, or might experience drought related problems that are similar to those your organization faces?
  
- 7.** What does a 'collaborative' drought planning effort would look like to you; (ie. what is collaboration)?
  
- 8.** Have you participated in collaborative efforts before? What did and did not go well? (What are some of the benefits and challenges that you feel could result from a collaborative planning process?)
  
- 9.** What do you/your organization need to get out of the collaborative, drought planning process, and/or having a comprehensive, District-wide drought plan in order to make it worth you/your organization's investment in time and resources?
  
- 10.** Discuss logistics hand-out for timeframe, role and responsibilities
